This communication model:

- Can be applied to any situation where teamwork and communication breakdowns occur over positions of right and wrong.
- Allows people to relate authentically and openly share beliefs and fears usually withheld in public discussions.
- Moves people beyond positions of right and wrong, and gives them access to generating actions and producing win/win results.
- Is not based on a need to agree.
- Begins to dissolve fears and produce actions to protect all youth.
